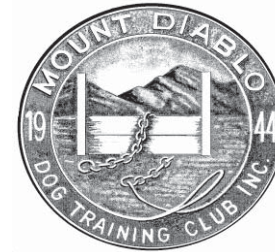

Notice to Exhibitors: A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog entered and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for each class entered are required at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. The fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club (American Kennel Club rules, Chapter 11, Section 2). At every licensed or member club Rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each entry of each dog. (Rally Regulations chapter 1, Section 3)

MOVE-UPS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY WILL BE ALLOWED PROVIDING THERE IS SPACE AVAILABE IN THE CLASSES AND PROVIDED THE TRIAL SECRETARY IS NOTIFIED IN WRITING AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO JUDGING.

EXHIBITORS: Please review the requirements for entry in the Novice A class.

Additional Rules Adopted By Mt. Diablo Dog Training Club, Inc.

MOVE-UP POLICY—The club will allow an exhibitor whose dog completes a title after close of entries but before the day of the trial to move their obedience entry from Novice to Open to Open to Utility (provided the class has not reached its limit) or their rally entry from Novice to Advanced or Advanced to Excellent. The request must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30minutes before the trial begins.

1. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
2. Refunds will made only on written request received before the close of entries
3. There will be no admission charge for spectators at this Trial
4. Dogs may be removed from the Trial when they are no longer needed for further judging or awards.
5. In case of a tie for awards, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits its right to the awards
6. Consult Judging Program for the time of judging. Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
7. Exhibitors are request to place awnings and canopies only within designated areas and keep area clean

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

The ten parts of the CGC test are:

1. Accepting a Friendly Stranger
 2. Sitting Politely for Petting
 3. Appearance and Grooming
 4. Out for a Walk
 5. Walking through a Crowd
 6. Sit and Down on Command/ Staying in Place
 7. Coming when Called
 8. Reaction to Another Dog
 9. Reaction to Distractions
 10. Supervised Separation
- Your dog must pass all ten parts to be awarded the CGC certificate.
- Certificates and collar tags are available from the AKC. Order forms will be provided.

From the AKC website:

Before taking the Canine Good Citizen test, owners will sign the Responsible Dog Owners Pledge. We believe that responsible dog ownership is a key part of the CGC concept and by signing the pledge, owners agree to take care of their dog's health needs, safety, exercise, training and quality of life. Owners also agree to show responsibility by doing things such as cleaning up after their dogs in public places and never letting dogs infringe on the rights of others.
